School COVID-19 Guidelines

The following guidelines will be evaluated and updated regularly based on the latest CDC and government guidelines.. Prior to attending our program we will need signed documentation and Consent from the PARENTS for EACH STUDENT.

Arrival Procedures

1. Please arrive on time! Punctuality is crucial in order to properly enforce our safety procedures.
2. To minimize exposure, dancers will enter the building one at a time and parents/guardians dropping off and picking up students will not enter the studio. Procedures will be in place to ensure that this process happens safely and smoothly.
3. All staff and students are required to wear a face mask while entering the building.
4. We will check students temperatures before entering the building
5. Dancer will arrive dressed, will not change leotards, will not leave anything in the studio overnight.
6. Regulatory black leotard, pink tights, hair up is mandatory
7. Limit 12 members per 1000 sq ft
8. Staff and students will be asked to use hand sanitizer upon entering the building.
9. The lobby will be closed to families until further notice. Only staff and students may use the lobby.
10. The dressing room is closed.
11. Bring food to each dance day (Lunch will happen in the Studio three).

Class Procedures

1. Class size will be limited to 12 dancers in our large studio, 6 dancers in our Studio 2, and lunch in Studio 3.
2. All staff and students are required to wear a face mask while in the dance studio.
3. Students will dance in 6' x 6' squares to ensure social distancing. There will be no physical contact between dancers at any time. Any dancer who cannot follow the social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the building.
4. Water bottles and dance shoes are the only personal items allowed in the classroom. The onsite water fountain will be off limits at this time.
5. The bathroom will be designated for one person per use. It will be continuously sanitized between uses.

Dismissal Procedures

1. Each student will be released one at a time from the building.
2. The lost and found has been removed. Any personal items that are left behind will be discarded.
3. Students who wish to carpool must provide a written or emailed note of consent from both parents/guardians.

Cleaning/Safety Procedures

1. Staff will steam mop the dance floors and sanitize the restrooms, ballet barres, doorknobs, and other hard surfaces daily.
2. A deep cleaning of the building will take place once a week by a professional company.
3. A designated staff member will be tasked with enforcing social distancing as well as frequent cleaning of all high-contact surfaces throughout our hours of operation.

Illness Procedures

1. If you have a cough, fever or are sick please stay home. You are welcome to participate in virtual classes instead.
2. Please, do not come to the studio if you or someone you have been exposed to tested positive, or had COVID-like symptoms, within the past 14 days.
3. We reserve the right to take temperatures of anyone entering the studio using non-contact, infrared thermometers. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 °F, or above, will be ask to leave the studio.
4. Dancers who test positive for Covid-19 must remain home until they have been cleared by a doctor and must provide documentation.
